

## CALL FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST FROM PRACTICE NURSES

### **RE: University of Sydney Short Course Development Working Party**

Sydney Nursing School is calling for expressions of interest from Practice Nurses who have expertise or interest in emerging infectious diseases and/or infection control. Your expertise is required for the development of an educational short course to be offered in General Practice.

Sydney Medical School at the University of Sydney has already developed a range of short courses for General Practice. In conjunction with the Sydney Emerging Infections and Biosecurity Institute (SEIB) and Sydney Nursing School, the group is looking to develop a short course on infectious diseases, focussing on the broad range of animal diseases that may affect humans (zoonoses).

The intention is that this short course will also be offered to Practice Nurses, Nurse Practitioners and Community Nurses. We therefore believe it is very important to have nursing representation on this working party, specifically relating to the context of nursing in general or private practice.

We do not envisage the working party (likely to be held in early December) to be a long-term commitment, nor to involve any writing. Your participation is required for representation of the profession and to ensure that the short course program is appropriate to the development needs and context of Practice Nursing. You would be attending the working party with a member of academic staff from Sydney Nursing School.

We are happy to discuss remuneration for travel or other expenses that may be incurred as a result of your participation.
